# Introducing the NHC Hospitality Partner

## **NHC** Approved Balls

For NHC 2014, two balls have been approved for The traditional Oakhurst/NHC ball is the play. ball being sold on the NHC entry form. Additional balls are available at Oakhurst from Pete. The second ball approved is the Brown/McIntyre "Braid" ball. It will be available for sale at Oakhurst during the NHC from Dave Brown at a cost of \$12.00 each. Rules governing the use of balls will be the same as last year. A variety of ball put in play on the first hole of any stipulated round (9 holes) must be used for the entirety of that round. The variety of ball may be switched after completing 9 holes before beginning the second 9-hole round of the day. When switching make sure you advise your playing partners and mark your ball. Scorecards for the competition rounds have a spot for you to indicate which ball you are playing that nine. (also see "Balls," side 2)

The Clan Match Championship is for foursomes teams of familial relatives (you know who you are). The group of longest standing is stroke play foursomes in two flights. You may sign up for either Open Match or Stroke Play unless you finished in the top eight of the Open Division in 2014 or plan to play with a family relative.
