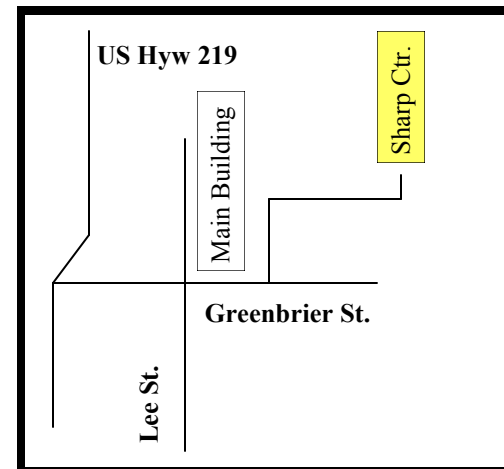

Rules for foursomes play in the
Elmore Just Foursomes Competition

(Regular) Foursomes

Teams of two players decide who will drive on each hole. Player A will hit from the tee on odd numbered holes (1, 3, 5, 7, 9), Player B will hit from the tee on even holes (2, 4, 6, 8).

Players hit alternate strokes after the tee shot.

A penalty stroke, when applied, does not take a turn. [If Player A hits into the water from the tee, Player B is now playing the third shot from the point of relief.]

Be careful on tap-in putts to ensure that alternate strokes are taken. When a player has hit twice in succession, the second stroke is taken over by the correct player and a penalty of two strokes is added.

Hole all putts, count all strokes because this is medal (stroke) play.

All normal NHC Rules (in the rule book) apply.

Foursomes (Clan and Match Eight)

Same rules as in the above box, except...

On the green, play stymies. The obstructing ball may only be moved if it is within 6 inches of the hole or six inches from the ball in play.

Match play rules are in force: teams may concede putts or holes, keep hole by hole score (not stroke score), if tied at the end of nine holes, play extra holes to decide the winning team.
