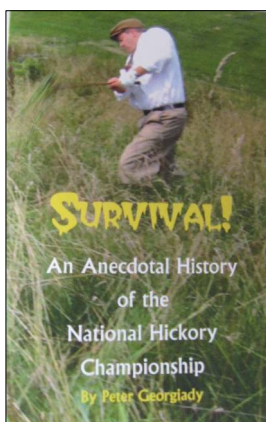
Junior Players for 2012
